## SACRAL STUDY UPDATE

Enrollment for Sacral study has been low. Total enrollment stands to 60 as of today. Going forward, we intend to use more sites to enroll. All patients who qualify are offered the study, but as in all trauma studies, the planned long term follow up is the problem. That been said, we have a good number for the pilot study and the data we are generating will be very helpful. We have submitted this study for OTA funding and a RedCap program has been written for entering data. However currently it is unfunded for per patient enrollment.

## IMPRESS STUDY UPDATE



The enrollment for IMPRESS has been sluggish and has enrolled only 10 subjects in last 6 months bring the total enrollment to 76. Approaches to increase the enrollment rate are being sought and would be discussed in depth during the OTRC meeting in San Antonio.
